



Roofing Update

Our Roofing Project is set to start shortly. We have chosen Provincial Roofing to go ahead and re-shingle the church roof as well as repair and replace the flat roof. The total for this work is \$149,764.55 (for a full breakdown of pricing and to view the project details please see the poster at the back of the church). We are using Parishioner Donations as well as funds from the Franciscan Friars to pay for this work to be done. If you wish to donate towards the roofing project, we encourage you to use the green "Roofing Envelopes" located at the back of the church. Any donations made directly to the Roofing Project are exempt from the 15% Archdiocese Assessment and 100% of the donation will be put towards the roof.
